

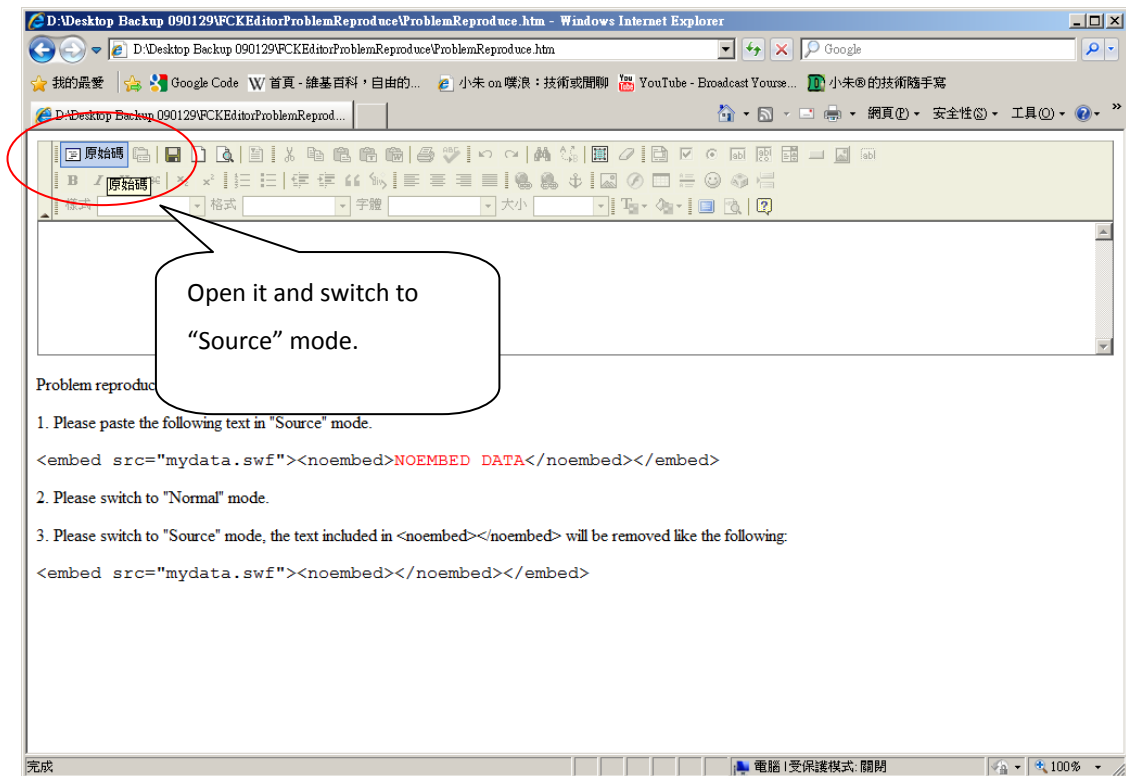



2. Please open ProblemReproduce.htm , and switch to “Source” mode:




3. Paste the code into editor.



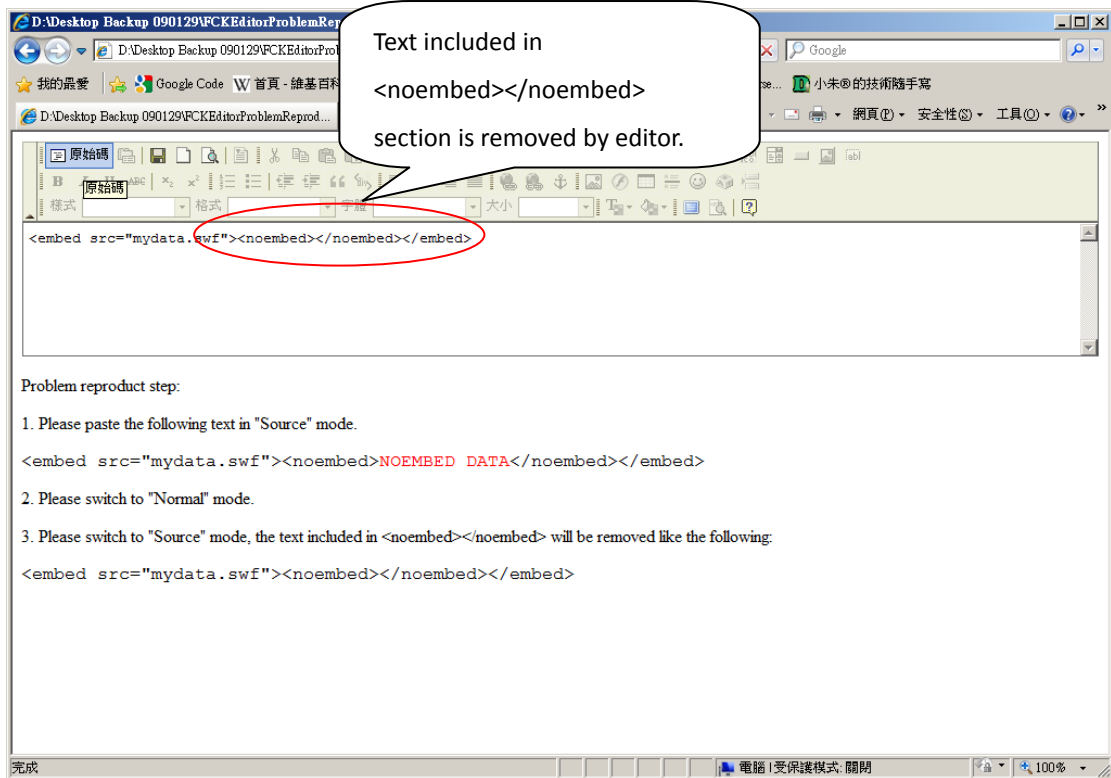
